We have requested another \$300,000 from SWFWMD for the continuation of drainage projects. As with the project on Renatta, we receive 50% funding for these projects through a grant from SWFWMD. We are hoping for the best and that we keep receiving these monies. The next project slated is Los Altos Drive and part of Bluff View Drive. The bridge is done! What a beautiful thing; the wide roads, decorative street lights, new boat ramp, on and on. This is a great addition to our city.

Yes, I have to mention it again-NPDES. By now everyone should know what this is. If not, I'll catch you up. National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System. In short, it means that the water drained from our roads has to be permitted through this program. It's more complicated than that, but that is it in a nut shell.
